ANSTINE, Rev. Dene W. Jr. age 84, of Springfield passed away on January 1, 2013. He was born April 18, 1928 in Washington Court House, OH to the late Dene W. and Bessie (Sibole) Anstine Sr. In addition to his parents, Dene is preceded in death by his brother, Robert Anstine and sisters: Anna Mae Strader, Verna Sebold and Helen Marlene Anstine. 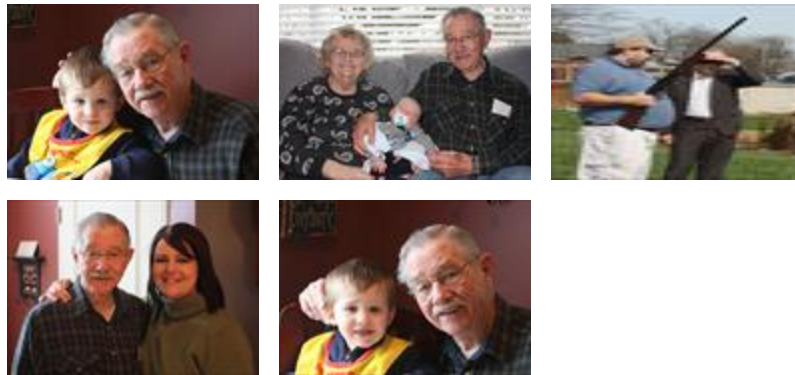
