



## Jerry Myra (Wilson) Bradley

Jerry Myra (Wilson) Bradley was born in Morehead Kentucky on August 7, 1940 to Marvin Holt Wilson and Juanita Mutters Wilson. She passed away at Hospice of Dayton on Easter Sunday, March 27, 2016 at the age of 75 after a short illness.

She married Robert Bradley on October 19, 1957. In 2008 she began a service in her church as a Family History missionary which put her in touch with people all over the world. She served in this position up until shortly before her death.

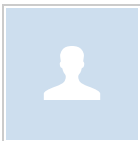


“ Dear family-

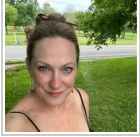
