Maxine Raudebaugh went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 7, 2013, at the age of 89. She leaves behind her loving husband of 65 years, Richard Raudebaugh, of Springfield, OH, 89. Maxine was the mother of three daughters (Linda Nelson, Peggy Walder, Donna Magnussen) and one son (Glen Raudebaugh) who preceded her in death in 1988. She was grandmother to 12, great grandmother to 15, and great-great grandmother to 2.

Born the daughter of Marvin P. Goff and Ida P. Goff, Maxine was raised in the Firestone Park area of Akron, OH. She graduated from Garfield High School in 1940. Maxine and Richard were residents of Mogadore until 1963 when they moved to Stow. They later moved to Charlotte, NC, in 1982 until 1995 at which time they returned to the Stow/Kent area of Ohio. Having experienced both sets of parents retiring to the Ohio Masonic Home in Springfield, OH, Dick and Maxine took up residency there in Fall of 2012.

Maxine had a very strong faith in God and committed her life to His service. She had her gaze fixed on eternity and the hope of God's promise of life ever after has been fulfilled. While her family will miss her, they are rejoicing in knowing that it is but a brief parting until that day that they are reunited in Heaven.

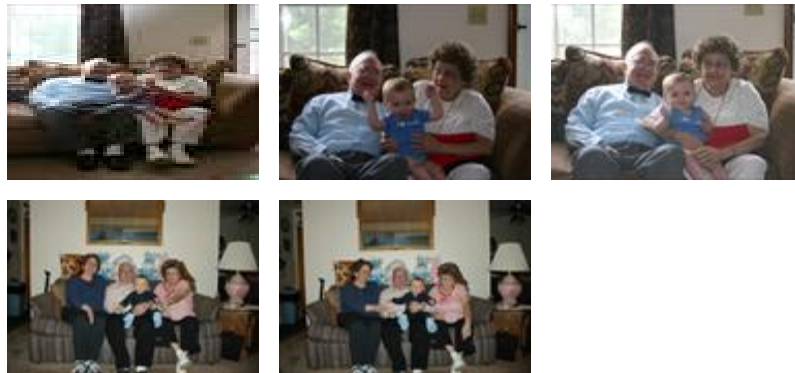
