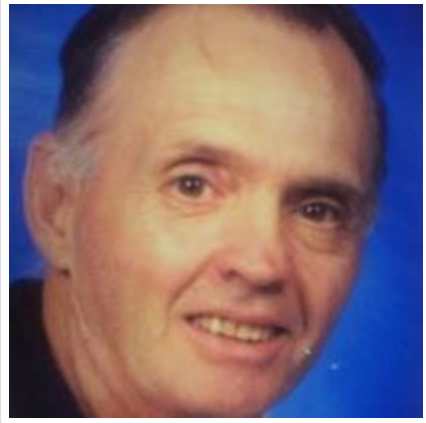




William Alfred "Mike" Lisch Jr
